6	SECTION 1. Sections 223.201(f) and (i), Transportation

15	(3) the Interstate Highway 35E managed lanes project
16	in Dallas and Denton Counties from Interstate Highway 635 to U.S.

18	(4) the North Tarrant Express project in Tarrant and

- 21 SECTION 2. Section 223.201(h), Transportation Code, is
- 22 repealed.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
