- 2 relating to fire code certificates of compliance.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 233.064, Local Government Code, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsections (f) and (g) and adding Subsections
- 6 (h) and (i) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) The county shall issue a final certificate of compliance
- 8 to the owner of a building inspected under this section if the
- 9 inspector determines, after an inspection of the completed
- 10 building, that the building complies with the fire code. For a
- 11 <u>building or complex of buildings involving phased completion or</u>
- 12 <u>build-out</u>, the county may issue a partial certificate of compliance
- 13 for any portion of the building or complex the inspector determines
- 14 is in substantial compliance with the fire code.
- 15 (g) If the inspector determines, after an inspection of the
- 16 completed building, that the building does not comply with the fire
- 17 code, the county may:
- 18 (1) [the county shall] deny the certificate of
- 19 compliance; <u>or</u> [and]
- 20 (2) <u>issue a conditional or partial certificate of</u>
- 21 <u>compliance and allow</u> the building <u>to</u> [may not] be occupied.
- 22 (h) A county that issues a conditional certificate of
- 23 compliance under Subsection (g) shall notify the owner of the
- 24 building of the violations of the fire code and establish a

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- 1 reasonable time to remedy the violations. A county may revoke a
- 2 conditional certificate of compliance if the owner does not remedy
- 3 the violations within the time specified on the conditional
- 4 certificate of compliance.
- 5 (i) A building may not be occupied until a county issues a
- 6 final, conditional, or partial certificate of compliance for the
- 7 building.
- 8 SECTION 2. A county may issue a partial or conditional
- 9 certificate of compliance under Section 233.064(f) or (g), Local
- 10 Government Code, as amended by this Act, on or after the effective
- 11 date of this Act to any building or complex of buildings that
- 12 qualifies for the partial or conditional certificate of compliance,
- 13 regardless of whether the building project started before, on, or
- 14 after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
