A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of a gas corporation to use a public right-of-way along a railroad, a railroad right-of-way, 3 an interurban railroad, or a street railroad. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 181.005(a), Utilities Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 (a) A gas corporation has the right to lay and maintain 8 9 lines over, along, under, and across a public road, [a railroad, railroad right-of-way,] an interurban railroad, a street railroad, 10 a canal or stream, or a municipal street or alley and over, under, 11 and across a railroad or a railroad right-of-way only if: 12 13 the pipeline complies with: (1)14 (A) all safety regulations adopted by the Railroad Commission of Texas and all federal regulations relating 15 16 to pipeline facilities and pipelines; and all rules adopted by the Texas Department of 17 (B) Transportation or the Railroad Commission of Texas and all federal 18 regulations regarding the accommodation of utility facilities on a 19 20 right-of-way, including regulations relating to the horizontal or 21 vertical placement of the pipeline; and 22 (2) the owner or operator of the pipeline ensures that 23 the public right-of-way and any associated facility are promptly restored to their former condition of usefulness after the 24

1 installation or maintenance of the pipeline.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
