H.B. No. 2298

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the hours during which the polls are open for early voting by personal appearance. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.004(d), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (d) The [If early voting by personal appearance is required to be conducted for extended hours under Section 85.005(c) or for 8 weekend hours under Section 85.006(e), the] registrar's office 9 shall remain open for providing voter registration information 10 during the [extended hours or weekend] hours that the main early 11 12 voting polling place is open for voting. SECTION 2. Section 85.005, Election Code, is amended by 13 14 amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to

15 read as follows:

(a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), (c-1), or (d), in an election in which a county clerk or city secretary is the early voting clerk under Section 83.002 or 83.005, early voting by personal appearance at the main early voting polling place shall be conducted on the weekdays of the early voting period and during the hours that the county clerk's or city secretary's main business office is regularly open for business.

(c) In a county with a population of 100,000 or more <u>but less</u>
<u>than three million</u>, the voting in a primary election or the general

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1 election for state and county officers shall be conducted at the main early voting polling place for at least 12 hours on each 2 3 weekday of the last week of the early voting period, and the voting in a special election ordered by the governor shall be conducted at 4 5 the main early voting polling place for at least 12 hours on each of the last two days of the early voting period. Voting shall be 6 conducted in accordance with this subsection in those elections in 7 8 a county with a population under 100,000 on receipt by the early voting clerk of a written request for the extended hours submitted 9 10 by at least 15 registered voters of the county. The request must be submitted in time to enable compliance with Section 85.067. 11

12 (c-1) In a county with a population of three million or 13 more, the voting in a primary election, the general election for 14 state and county officers, or a special election ordered by the 15 governor shall be conducted at the main early voting polling place 16 from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. on each weekday of the early voting period.

17 SECTION 3. Section 85.006(e), Election Code, is amended to 18 read as follows:

19 (e) In a primary election or the general election for state and county officers in a county with a population of 100,000 or 20 more, the early voting clerk shall order personal appearance voting 21 at the main early voting polling place to be conducted for at least 22 23 12 hours on the last Saturday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on the last Saturday in a county with a population of three million or more, and 24 for at least five hours on the last Sunday of the early voting 25 26 period. The early voting clerk shall order voting to be conducted at those times in those elections in a county with a population 27

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1 under 100,000 on receipt of a written request for those hours 2 submitted by at least 15 registered voters of the county. The 3 request must be submitted in time to enable compliance with Section 4 85.007. This subsection supersedes any provision of this subchapter 5 to the extent of any conflict.

6 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 7 an election for which early voting begins on or after September 1, 8 2011.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
