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- 1 to recipients who are not married, except for counseling and

- 10 (g) Not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year,
- 11 the department shall submit a report to the legislature regarding
- 12 the department's progress in [establishing and] operating the

- 14 (h) The department shall ensure the money spent under the
- 15 demonstration project, regardless of the funding source, is not
- 16 used to perform or promote elective abortions. [The department, for
- 17 the purpose of the demonstration project, may not contract with
- 18 entities that perform or promote elective abortions or are
- 19 affiliates of entities that perform or promote elective abortions.
- 20 (i) This section expires September 1, 2016 [2011].
- 21 SECTION 2. If before implementing Section 32.0248, Human
- 22 Resources Code, as amended by this Act, a state agency determines
- 23 that an amendment to the existing waiver or other authorization is
- 24 necessary to extend the operation of the demonstration project for
- 25 women's health care services under that section as amended, the
- 26 agency affected by the provision shall request the amendment to the
- 27 waiver or other authorization and may delay implementing that

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- 1 section until the amendment or other authorization is granted.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect August 31, 2011.
