- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 411.101, Labor Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 411.101. LEGISLATIVE POLICY; PURPOSE. It is the
- 8 policy of this state to protect the health and welfare of its people
- 9 and to reduce and, to every reasonable extent, eliminate the causes
- 10 of loss of production, reduction of work hours, temporary and
- 11 permanent incapacity of workers, and increases in certain insurance
- 12 rates by:
- 13 (1) promoting the adoption, application, and
- 14 implementation of safety measures in industry and enterprise;
- 15 (2) protecting workers against unsafe and hazardous
- 16 working conditions, including other relevant health and safety
- 17 components of the working environment such as air quality; and
- 18 (3) encouraging correction of any unsafe and hazardous
- 19 working conditions in industry and enterprise, including other
- 20 relevant health and safety components of the working environment
- 21 such as air quality.
- SECTION 2. Section 411.103, Labor Code, is amended to read
- 23 as follows:
- Sec. 411.103. DUTY OF EMPLOYER TO PROVIDE SAFE WORKPLACE.

- 1 Each employer shall:
- 2 (1) provide and maintain employment and a place of
- 3 employment that is reasonably safe and healthful for employees;
- 4 (2) install, maintain, and use methods, processes,
- 5 devices, and safeguards, including methods of sanitation and
- 6 hygiene, that are reasonably necessary to protect the life, health,
- 7 and safety of the employer's employees, including other relevant
- 8 health and safety components of the working environment such as air
- 9 quality; and
- 10 (3) take all other actions reasonably necessary to
- 11 make the employment and place of employment safe and healthy,
- 12 including other relevant health and safety components of the
- 13 working environment such as air quality.
- 14 SECTION 3. The legislature finds that the quality of the air
- 15 or other health and safety components in appropriate places of
- 16 employment and appropriate places that are accessible to the public
- 17 shall be maintained and improved with effective and necessary
- 18 measures, prescribed by statute or rule, that protect the general
- 19 health, safety, and welfare.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
