A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to notification of local groundwater conservation
- 3 districts by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality when
- 4 groundwater contamination is found.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 5.236(a), Water Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (a) If the executive director acquires information that
- 9 confirms that a potential public health hazard exists because
- 10 usable groundwater has been or is being contaminated, the executive
- 11 director, not later than the 30th day after the date on which the
- 12 executive director acquires the information confirming
- 13 contamination, shall give written notice of the contamination to
- 14 the following persons:
- 15 (1) the county judge and the county health officer, if
- 16 any, in each county in which the contamination has occurred or is
- 17 occurring;
- 18 (2) <u>each groundwater district with authority under</u>
- 19 Chapter 36 or other law to regulate water wells located in the area
- 20 affected by the groundwater that has been or is being contaminated;
- 21 (3) any person under the commission's jurisdiction who
- 22 is suspected of contributing to the contamination; and
- (4) $[\frac{(3)}{(3)}]$ any other state agency with jurisdiction
- 24 over any person who is suspected of contributing to the

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- 1 contamination.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
