## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of plumbing.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1301.304, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 6 (d) Unless a threat to health or safety exists, the board
- 7 may not investigate a complaint in which the person filing the
- 8 complaint and the person who is the subject of the complaint are
- 9 engaged in litigation related to the subject matter of the
- 10 complaint until the outcome of the litigation is finally
- 11 determined.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 1301.552, Occupations Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 1301.552. CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE FOR PLUMBING PERMIT
- 15 IN POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. A political subdivision that requires a
- 16 responsible master plumber or an agent of a responsible master
- 17 <u>plumber</u> [<del>plumbing contractor</del>] to obtain a permit before performing
- 18 plumbing in the political subdivision shall verify through the
- 19 board's Internet website, or by contacting the board by telephone,
- 20 that the <u>responsible master plumber</u> [plumbing contractor] has on
- 21 file with the board a certificate of insurance. The certificate of
- 22 insurance must:
- 23 (1) be written by a company licensed to do business in
- 24 this state;

- 1 (2) provide for commercial general liability
- 2 insurance for the  $\underline{\text{responsible}}$  master plumber for a claim for
- 3 property damage or bodily injury, regardless of whether the claim
- 4 arises from negligence or on a contract; and
- 5 (3) provide coverage of not less than \$300,000 for all
- 6 claims arising in a one-year period.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
