- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 21.3541 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 21.3541. APPRAISAL OF ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS AND
- 9 DEPARTMENT HEADS. (a) In addition to the appraisal required under
- 10 this subchapter, the board of trustees of a school district may
- 11 provide an appraisal process and criteria on which to appraise the
- 12 performance of:
- (1) each school assistant principal by each teacher at
- 14 the school who is the department chair for a subject area or grade
- 15 level; and
- 16 (2) each teacher who is the department chair for a
- 17 subject area or grade level, on the basis of the teacher's
- 18 performance as department chair, by the other teachers in the
- 19 subject area or at the grade level for which the department chair
- 20 <u>has supervisory responsibilities.</u>
- 21 (b) An assistant principal or department chair may not be
- 22 appraised under the appraisal process adopted under this section
- 23 more than once each school year.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
