7 (a-1) A person who voluntarily accepts an assignment in a

8 new professional capacity that requires a different class of

9 certificate under Subchapter B than the class of certificate held

10 by the person in the professional capacity in which the person was

11 previously employed may be employed under a probationary contract.

12 This subsection does not apply to a person who is returned by a

school district to a professional capacity in which the person was

employed by the district before the district employed the person in

15 the new professional capacity as described by this subsection. A

16 person described by this subsection who is returned to a previous

17 professional capacity is entitled to be employed in the original

18 professional capacity under the same contractual status as the

19 status held by the person during the previous employment by the

20 <u>district in that capacity.</u>

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
