entitled to be employed in the original professional capacity
under the same contractual status as the status held by the person
during the previous employment by the district in that capacity.

4 <u>(a-2)</u> A person who previously was employed as a teacher by a 5 district and, after at least a two-year lapse in district 6 employment returns to district employment, may be employed under a 7 probationary contract.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
