- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.102, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Section 21.202(b), the following
- 9 persons shall be employed under a probationary contract:
- 10 (1) a person who is employed as a teacher by a school
- 11 district for the first time;
- 12 $\underline{\text{(2)}}$ a person $[\tau]$ who has not been employed by the
- 13 district for two consecutive school years subsequent to August 28,
- 14 1967; and
- 15 (3) a person who is employed in a new professional
- 16 capacity that requires a different class of certificate under
- 17 Subchapter B than the class of certificate held by the person in the
- 18 professional capacity in which the person was previously employed [τ
- 19 shall be employed under a probationary contract].
- 20 $\underline{(a-1)}$ A person who previously was employed as a teacher by a
- 21 district and, after at least a two-year lapse in district
- 22 employment returns to district employment, may be employed under a
- 23 probationary contract.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
