- 7 Art. 63.0515. CRIMINAL JUSTICE AGENCY. For purposes of
- 8 this subchapter, the center is a criminal justice agency that
- 9 performs forensic DNA analyses on evidence, including evidence
- 10 related to a case involving unidentified human remains or a
- 11 high-risk missing person. The center shall comply with 42 U.S.C.
- 12 <u>Section 14132.</u>
- SECTION 2. Article 63.052(b), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 14 is amended to read as follows:
- 15 (b) The [sole purpose of the] database may be used [is] to
- 16 identify unidentified human remains and high-risk missing persons.
- SECTION 3. Article 63.052(c), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 18 is repealed.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
