A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the implementation of the administration of certain
- 3 assessment instruments for public school students.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(a-2)</u> An assessment instrument administered in the
- 8 2011-2012 or 2012-2013 school year must be in the same form as an
- 9 assessment instrument administered in the 2010-2011 school year.
- 10 SECTION 2. Sections 39.025(f) and (g), Education Code, are
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (f) The commissioner shall by rule adopt a transition plan
- 13 to implement the amendments made by Chapter 1312 (S.B. No. 1031),
- 14 Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, replacing
- 15 general subject assessment instruments administered at the high
- 16 school level with end-of-course assessment instruments. The rules
- 17 must provide for the end-of-course assessment instruments adopted
- 18 under Section 39.023(c) to be administered beginning with students
- 19 entering the ninth grade during the 2013-2014 [2011-2012] school
- 20 year. During the period under which the transition to
- 21 end-of-course assessment instruments is made:
- 22 (1) for students entering a grade above the ninth
- 23 grade during the 2013-2014 [$\frac{2011-2012}{2}$] school year, the
- 24 commissioner shall retain, administer, and use for purposes of

- 1 accreditation and other campus and district accountability
- 2 measures under this chapter the assessment instruments required by
- 3 Section 39.023(a) or (c), as that section existed before amendment
- 4 by Chapter 1312 (S.B. No. 1031), Acts of the 80th Legislature,
- 5 Regular Session, 2007;
- 6 (2) a student subject to Subdivision (1) may not
- 7 receive a high school diploma unless the student has performed
- 8 satisfactorily on each required assessment instrument administered
- 9 under Section 39.023(c) as that section existed before amendment by
- 10 Chapter 1312 (S.B. No. 1031), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
- 11 Session, 2007; and
- 12 (3) the agency may defer releasing assessment
- 13 instrument questions and answer keys as required by Section
- 14 39.023(e) to the extent necessary to develop additional assessment
- 15 instruments.
- 16 (g) Rules adopted under Subsection (f) must require that
- 17 each student who will be subject to the requirements of Subsection
- 18 (a) is entitled to notice of the specific requirements applicable
- 19 to the student. Notice under this subsection must be provided not
- 20 later than the date the student enters the eighth
- 21 grade. Subsection (f) and this subsection expire September 1, $\underline{2017}$
- [2015].
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
