- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 6.710, Family Code, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 6.710. COPY OF DECREE. The petitioner in a suit for
- 9 dissolution of a marriage [clerk of the court] shall mail a copy of
- 10 the final decree of dissolution of a marriage to the party who
- 11 waived service of process under Section 6.4035 by mailing the copy
- 12 of the decree to the party at the mailing address contained in the
- 13 waiver or to the office of the party's attorney of record.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 6.710, Family Code, as amended by this
- 15 Act, applies to a suit for dissolution of a marriage filed on or
- 16 after the effective date of this Act. A suit for dissolution of a
- 17 marriage filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 18 the law in effect on the date the suit was filed, and the former law
- 19 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
