- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 41, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 41.015 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 41.015. INTEREST ON DAMAGES SUBJECT TO MEDICARE
- 7 SUBROGATION. Interest does not accrue on the unpaid balance of an
- 8 award of damages to a plaintiff if the United States has a
- 9 subrogation right to the award under 42 U.S.C. Section
- 10 1395y(b)(2)(B) until the defendant receives a recovery demand
- 11 letter issued by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services or a
- 12 <u>designated contractor under 42 C.F.R. Section 411.22.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an award of damages made on or after the effective date of this
- 15 Act. An award of damages made before the effective date of this Act
- 16 is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and
- 17 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
