A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the offense of remaining, parking vehicles, or erecting
- 3 structures on certain state property.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 545.411, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 545.411. USE OF REST AREA OR RIGHT-OF-WAY: OFFENSE.
- 8 SECTION 2. Sections 545.411(a) and (c), Transportation
- 9 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) A person commits an offense if the person remains or
- 11 parks a vehicle on state highway right-of-way or at a rest area for
- 12 longer than 24 hours or erects a tent, shelter, booth, or structure
- 13 on state highway right-of-way or at the rest area and the person:
- 14 (1) has notice while conducting the activity that the
- 15 activity is prohibited; or
- 16 (2) receives notice that the activity is prohibited
- 17 but does not depart or remove the <u>vehicle or</u> structure within eight
- 18 hours after receiving notice.
- 19 (c) It is an exception to Subsection (a) if $\underline{\cdot}$
- 20 <u>(1)</u> a nonprofit organization erects a temporary
- 21 structure at a rest area to provide food services, food, or
- 22 beverages to travelers and the Texas Department of Transportation:
- (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ finds that the services would
- 24 constitute a public service for the benefit of the traveling

- 2 (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ issues a permit to the organization; or
- 3 (2) a person remains on or parks a vehicle on state
- 4 highway right-of-way:
- 5 (A) for emergency or highway construction and
- 6 maintenance purposes;
- 7 (B) within the corporate limits of a
- 8 municipality;
- 9 (C) for operations of an electric utility as
- 10 defined by Section 31.002, Utilities Code, or a gas utility as
- 11 defined by Section 101.003 or 121.001, Utilities Code, or for
- 12 surface coal mining and reclamation operations as defined by
- 13 <u>Section</u> 134.004, Natural Resources Code; or
- (D) as authorized under other state or local law,
- 15 <u>including a municipal ordinance</u>.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 21 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 23 before that date.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
