| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is |
| 6 | amended by adding Section 531.098 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 531.098. INDIGENT HEALTH CARE COLLABORATION. (a) The |
| 8 | executive commissioner shall adopt rules to foster collaboration |
| 9 | among and within systems that provide indigent health care services |
| 10 | in the state, including: |
| 11 | (1) hospital districts; |
| 12 | (2) public hospitals; |
| 13 | (3) indigent health care programs provided by |
| 14 | counties; |
| 15 | (4) community-owned health care systems; and |
| 16 | (5) federally qualified health centers. |
| 17 | (b) The rules must: |
| 18 | (1) emphasize community-based care to improve the |
| 19 | continuity and quality of indigent health care; |
| 20 | (2) address the variation in indigent health care |
| 21 | services provided to urban and rural settings; |
| 22 | (3) remove legal and practical barriers to |
| 23 | collaboration; |
| 24 | (4) provide guidance to systems for detecting and |

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| 2 | (5) facilitate the creation of special programs to |
| 3 | assist patients in navigating the systems that provide indigent |
| 4 | health care services; and |
| 5 | (6) adopt changes that maximize funding and increase |
| 6 | the efficiency of indigent health care provided to communities in |
| 7 | the state. |
| 8 | (c) In adopting the rules, the executive commissioner shall |
| 9 | consider recommending that the systems described by Subsection (a) |
| 10 | incorporate the following principles: |
| 11 | (1) promote patient responsibility and program |
| 12 | <pre>viability;</pre> |
| 13 | (2) provide a medical home for members; |
| 14 | (3) make evidence-based health care decisions; |
| 15 | (4) pay providers based on a fee-for-service basis; |
| 16 | (5) ensure members receive necessary medication; and |
| 17 | (6) develop community partnerships to expand indigent |
| 18 | health care services. |
| 19 | SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and |
| 20 | Human Services Commission shall adopt the rules required by Section |
| 21 | 531.098, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than |
| 22 | January 1, 2012. |
| 23 | SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011. |

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
