8	LEGISLATOR [LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE]. (a) On request from a member
9	of the legislature [legislative committee created under Subchapter
10	B, Chapter 301, Government Code], the board shall release all
11	information regarding a complaint against a physician to aid in a
12	legitimate legislative inquiry. The board may release the
13	information only to the <u>member of the legislature</u> [members of the
14	committee].
15	(b) In complying with a request under Subsection (a), the
16	board <u>:</u>
17	(1) may not identify the [complainant or the] patient
18	unless the patient made the complaint;
19	(2) may not release any health care information
20	protected by state or federal law, including the patient's medical
21	record; and
22	(3) may require the member to sign a nondisclosure
23	agreement [and may reveal the identity of the affected physician
24	only to the members of the committee].
