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- 2 relating to the immunity of property tax arbitrators from liability
- 3 for determinations made in the course of binding arbitrations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 41A, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 41A.14 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 41A.14. IMMUNITY. An arbitrator appointed under this
- 8 chapter is immune from civil liability that is based on the
- 9 arbitrator's determination of the value of property or of the
- 10 appropriate award of any remedy or relief under Section 41A.09 as if
- 11 the arbitrator were a district judge making the determination. All
- 12 existing immunity granted arbitrators by law, express or implied,
- 13 <u>continues in full force and effect.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 16 this Act. A cause of action that accrued before the effective date
- 17 of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before
- 18 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 19 for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
