A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the regulation of sport bikes and certain other
3	motorcycles.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as Malorie's Law.
6	SECTION 2. Section 521.084, Transportation Code, is amended
7	to read as follows:
8	Sec. 521.084. CLASS M LICENSE. A Class M driver's license
9	authorizes the holder of the license to operate a motorcycle,
10	including a sport bike as defined by Section 541.201, or \underline{a} moped.
11	SECTION 3. Section 541.201, Transportation Code, is amended
12	by adding Subdivision (18-a) to read as follows:
13	(18-a) "Sport bike" means a motorcycle:
14	(A) that is optimized for speed, acceleration,
15	braking, and maneuverability on paved roads;
16	(B) that has a lightweight frame;
17	(C) on which the operator leans forward over the
18	gas tank during operation; and
19	(D) that is not a touring, cruising, standard, or
20	dual-sport motorcycle.
21	SECTION 4. Subchapter I, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
22	is amended by adding Section 545.4161 to read as follows:
23	Sec. 545.4161. OPERATION OF SPORT BIKE. (a) In addition to

the requirements and prohibitions under Section 545.416, an

- 1 operator may not carry another person on a sport bike unless the
- 2 sport bike is designed to carry more than one person and:
- 3 (1) the operator:
- 4 (A) is at least 18 years of age; and
- 5 (B) has had a Class M license for at least two
- 6 years; or
- 7 (2) the other person:
- 8 (A) is at least 18 years of age and holds a Class
- 9 M license; or
- 10 (B) is a motorcycle operator training and safety
- 11 course instructor certified under Chapter 662.
- 12 (b) An operator of a sport bike shall ensure that a
- 13 passenger on the sport bike complies with all department
- 14 regulations relating to motorcycle safety.
- SECTION 5. The heading to Subchapter M, Chapter 547,
- 16 Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 SUBCHAPTER M. ADDITIONAL OR ALTERNATIVE EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR
- MOTORCYCLES, [AND] MOTOR-DRIVEN CYCLES, AND SPORT BIKES
- 19 SECTION 6. Subchapter M, Chapter 547, Transportation Code,
- 20 is amended by adding Section 547.803 to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 547.803. SAFETY EQUIPMENT. If a motorcycle, including
- 22 <u>a sport bike</u>, is designed to carry more than one person, the
- 23 motorcycle must be equipped with foot pegs and handholds for use by
- 24 a passenger on the motorcycle.
- 25 SECTION 7. Section 661.001(1), Transportation Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- 27 (1) "Motorcycle" means a motor vehicle designed to

- 1 propel itself with not more than three wheels in contact with the
- 2 ground, and having a saddle for the use of the rider. The term
- 3 <u>includes a sport bike, as defined by Section 541.201.</u> The term does
- 4 not include a tractor or a three-wheeled vehicle equipped with a cab
- 5 or occupant compartment, seat, and seat belt and designed to
- 6 contain the operator in the cab or occupant compartment.
- 7 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
