- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as Malorie's Law.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 521.084, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 521.084. CLASS M LICENSE. A Class M driver's license
- 8 authorizes the holder of the license to operate a motorcycle,
- 9 <u>including a sport bike as defined by Section 541.201</u>, or <u>a</u> moped.
- SECTION 3. Section 541.201, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 by adding Subdivision (18-a) to read as follows:
- 12 (18-a) "Sport bike" means a motorcycle:
- (A) that is optimized for speed, acceleration,
- 14 braking, and maneuverability on paved roads;
- 15 <u>(B)</u> that has a lightweight frame;
- 16 (C) on which the operator leans forward over the
- 17 gas tank during operation; and
- 18 (D) that is not a touring, cruising, standard, or
- 19 <u>dual-sport motorcycle.</u>
- SECTION 4. Subchapter I, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
- 21 is amended by adding Section 545.4161 to read as follows:
- Sec. 545.4161. OPERATION OF SPORT BIKE. (a) In addition to
- 23 the requirements and prohibitions under Section 545.416, an
- 24 operator may not carry another person on a sport bike unless the

- 1 sport bike is designed to carry more than one person and:
- 2 (1) the operator:
- 3 (A) is at least 18 years of age; and
- 4 (B) has had a Class M license for at least two
- 5 years; or
- 6 (2) the other person:
- 7 (A) is at least 18 years of age and holds a Class
- 8 M license; or
- 9 (B) is a motorcycle operator training and safety
- 10 course instructor certified under Chapter 662.
- 11 (b) An operator of a sport bike shall ensure that a
- 12 passenger on the sport bike complies with all department
- 13 regulations relating to motorcycle safety.
- 14 SECTION 5. The heading to Subchapter M, Chapter 547,
- 15 Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 16 SUBCHAPTER M. ADDITIONAL OR ALTERNATIVE EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR
- 17 MOTORCYCLES, [AND] MOTOR-DRIVEN CYCLES, AND SPORT BIKES
- SECTION 6. Subchapter M, Chapter 547, Transportation Code,
- 19 is amended by adding Section 547.803 to read as follows:
- Sec. 547.803. SPORT BIKE SAFETY EQUIPMENT. If a sport bike
- 21 <u>is designed to carry more than one person, the sport bike must be</u>
- 22 equipped with foot pegs and handholds for use by a passenger on the
- 23 <u>sport bike.</u>
- SECTION 7. Section 661.001(1), Transportation Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (1) "Motorcycle" means a motor vehicle designed to
- 27 propel itself with not more than three wheels in contact with the

- 1 ground, and having a saddle for the use of the rider. The term
- 2 <u>includes a sport bike, as defined by Section 541.201.</u> The term does
- 3 not include a tractor or a three-wheeled vehicle equipped with a cab
- 4 or occupant compartment, seat, and seat belt and designed to
- 5 contain the operator in the cab or occupant compartment.
- 6 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
