17	register a motor vehicle that the person owns under Section

19	(2) is exempt from paying fees for vehicle
20	registration or renewal of vehicle registration, not including a
21	registration or renewal fee for a vehicle issued specialty or
22	personalized license plates or any additional or optional fee
23	authorized or imposed by this chapter.
