## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to patient safety plans for certain health care 3 facilities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 241, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subchapter H to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER H. PATIENT SAFETY PLANS 7 Sec. 241.201. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter 8 applies to a general or special hospital licensed under this 9 chapter or a similar hospital that is maintained or operated by this 10 state. 11 12 Sec. 241.202. PATIENT SAFETY PLAN. A hospital shall adopt and implement a patient safety plan based on evidence-based 13 14 protocols. Sec. 241.203. ANNUAL REPORT. (a) A hospital shall submit 15 16 an annual report to the department that: (1) identifies the protocols that are being used at 17 the hospital in accordance with the safety plan adopted under this 18 subchapter and describes the protocols in detail; and 19 (2) specifies in which hospital department each 20 21 protocol is used. 22 (b) The report must be submitted on a form prescribed by the 23 department. The department shall specify the reporting date. Sec. 241.204. DEPARTMENTAL SUMMARY. The department shall 24

5	SECTION 2. Chapter 243, Health and Safety Code, is amended

8	Sec. 243.051. PATIENT SAFETY PLAN. An ambulatory surgical
9	center shall adopt and implement a patient safety plan based on
10	evidence-based protocols.
11	Sec. 243.052. ANNUAL REPORT. (a) An ambulatory surgical
12	center shall submit an annual report to the department that
13	identifies the protocols that are being used at the ambulatory
14	surgical center in accordance with the safety plan adopted under
15	this subchapter and describes the protocols in detail.
16	(b) The report must be submitted on a form prescribed by the
17	department. The department shall specify the reporting date.
18	Sec. 243.053. DEPARTMENTAL SUMMARY. The department shall
19	compile a summary of the information submitted under Section
20	243.052. The department shall publish the summary at least
21	annually and shall make the summary available on the department's
22	Internet website.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
25	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
26	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

27 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
