- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 9.33, Penal Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 9.33. DEFENSE OF THIRD PERSON. (a) A person is
- 8 justified in using force or deadly force against another to protect
- 9 a third person if:
- 10 (1) under the circumstances as the actor reasonably
- 11 believes them to be, the actor would be justified under Section 9.31
- 12 or 9.32 in using force or deadly force to protect himself against
- 13 the unlawful force or unlawful deadly force he reasonably believes
- 14 to be threatening the third person he seeks to protect; and
- 15 (2) the actor reasonably believes that his
- 16 intervention is immediately necessary to protect the third person.
- 17 (b) For purposes of this section, "third person" does not
- 18 <u>include:</u>
- 19 (1) a human embryo that exists outside of a woman's
- 20 body; or
- 21 (2) an unborn child unless the actor is a pregnant
- 22 woman who is carrying that child.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
