5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 1702.1301 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1702.1301. RESTRICTIONS ON APPEARANCE OF VEHICLES.
8	(a) A motor vehicle used by a license holder, or an officer,
9	director, partner, manager, or employee of a license holder, in the
10	<pre>course of activity licensed by this chapter:</pre>
11	(1) must display an inscription containing:
12	(A) the company name of the license holder; and
13	(B) the words "Not Affiliated with Law
14	<pre>Enforcement"; and</pre>
15	(2) may not display the state seal or another seal or
16	any variation on the state seal or another seal that may give an
17	impression that the person is connected with the federal
18	government, a state government, or a political subdivision of this
19	state.
20	(b) The inscription required by Subsection (a) must be:
21	(1) in a color sufficiently different from the body of
22	the motor vehicle so that the lettering is plainly legible at a
23	distance of not less than 100 feet; and
24	(2) in letters not less than two inches high.
