- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 25.087, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-4) and amending Subsection (d) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b-4) A school district shall excuse for a maximum of 10
- 10 days a student whose parent or legal guardian is an active duty
- 11 member of the uniformed services as defined by Section 162.002 and
- 12 has been called to duty for, is on leave from, or immediately
- 13 returned from continuous deployment of at least six months outside
- 14 the locality where the parent or guardian regularly resides, to
- 15 visit with the student's parent or guardian. An excused absence
- 16 under this subsection must be taken:
- 17 (1) not earlier than the 60th day before the date of
- 18 <u>deployment; or</u>
- 19 (2) not later than the 30th day after the date of
- 20 <u>return from deployment.</u>
- 21 (d) A student whose absence is excused under Subsection (b),
- 22 (b-2), (b-4), or (c) may not be penalized for that absence and shall
- 23 be counted as if the student attended school for purposes of
- 24 calculating the average daily attendance of students in the school

- 1 district. A student whose absence is excused under Subsection (b),
- 2 (b-2),  $\underline{\text{(b-4)}}$ , or (c) shall be allowed a reasonable time to make up
- 3 school work missed on those days. If the student satisfactorily
- 4 completes the school work, the day of absence shall be counted as a
- 5 day of compulsory attendance.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
