- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 13.038, Election Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 13.038. POWERS GENERALLY; OFFENSE. (a) A volunteer
- 9 deputy registrar may distribute voter registration application
- 10 forms throughout the county and receive registration applications
- 11 submitted to the deputy in person.
- 12 (b) A volunteer deputy registrar commits an offense if the
- 13 volunteer deputy distributes a voter registration application form
- 14 to a person the volunteer deputy knows is ineligible to register to
- 15 vote under Section 13.001. An offense under this subsection is a
- 16 state jail felony.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 13.043, Election Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 13.043. FAILURE TO CONDUCT APPOINTED DUTIES [DELIVER
- 20 APPLICATION]. (a) A volunteer deputy registrar commits an offense
- 21 if the deputy fails to cause the proper and timely delivery of a
- 22 completed voter registration application as required by [comply
- 23 with] Section 13.042.
- 24 (a-1) A volunteer deputy registrar commits an offense if the

- 1 volunteer deputy knowingly causes a voter registration application
- 2 containing false information to be delivered to the registrar.
- 3 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an offense under
- 4 Subsection (a) [this section] is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 5 (c) An offense under Subsection (a) [this section] is a
- 6 Class A misdemeanor if the deputy's failure to comply is
- 7 intentional.
- 8 (d) An offense under Subsection (a-1) is a state jail
- 9 felony.
- 10 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 13 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 14 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes
- 15 of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date
- 16 of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
