- 12 with] Section 13.042.
- 13 <u>(a-1)</u> A volunteer deputy registrar commits an offense if the
- 14 volunteer deputy knowingly causes a voter registration application
- 15 containing false information to be delivered to the registrar.
- 16 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an offense under
- 17 Subsection (a) [this section] is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 18 (c) An offense under <u>Subsection (a)</u> [this section] is a
- 19 Class A misdemeanor if the deputy's failure to comply is
- 20 intentional.
- 21 (d) An offense under Subsection (a-1) is a state jail
- 22 felony.
- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 3 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes
- 4 of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date
- 5 of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
