- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 65, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 5 Sections 65.016 and 65.017 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 65.016. The Elections Administrator may
- 7 electronically file mail-in ballot applications and mail-in
- 8 ballots. The electronically filed mail-in ballot applications and
- 9 mail-in ballots shall be sufficient for the Early Voting Ballot
- 10 Board to compare signatures between the mail-in ballot application
- 11 and the mail-in ballot.
- 12 <u>Sec. 65.017. The Secretary of State also</u> [has authority to]
- 13 may adopt administrative rules regarding the requirements for the
- 14 electronic image quality and storage of the electronic images of
- 15 the mail-in ballot applications and mail-in ballots. [to gain
- 16 uniformity in interpretation of state election laws and

- 23 submitted as provided by this section.

- 2 (1) mail;
- 3 (2) common or contract carrier; or
- 4 (3) Electronic copy of the original application.
- 5 [telephonic facsimile machine, scanned images that are emailed if
- 6 the applicant is absent from the county and if a machine is
- 7 available in the clerk's office. The Secretary of State may adopt
- 8 requirements for the quality of the electronic copies.
- 9 (c) An application must be submitted on or after the 60th
- 10 day before election day and before the close of regular business in
- 11 the early voting clerk's office or 12 noon, whichever is later, on
- 12 the seventh day before election day unless that day is a Saturday,
- 13 Sunday, or legal state or national holiday, in which case the last
- 14 day is the first preceding regular business day.
- 15 (d) An application is considered to be submitted at the time
- 16 of its receipt by the clerk.
