- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.07, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Transportation, lodging, and meals described by
- 8 Subsection (b) are not political contributions as defined by Title
- 9 <u>15, Election Code.</u>
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 36.10(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 (a) Sections 36.08 (Gift to Public Servant) and 36.09
- 13 (Offering Gift to Public Servant) do not apply to:
- 14 (1) a fee prescribed by law to be received by a public
- 15 servant or any other benefit to which the public servant is lawfully
- 16 entitled or for which he gives legitimate consideration in a
- 17 capacity other than as a public servant;
- 18 (2) a gift or other benefit conferred on account of
- 19 kinship or a personal, professional, or business relationship
- 20 independent of the official status of the recipient; or
- 21 (3) a benefit to a public servant required to file a
- 22 statement under Chapter 572, Government Code, or a report under
- 23 Title 15, Election Code, that is derived from a function in honor or
- 24 appreciation of the recipient if:

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- 1 (A) the benefit and the source of any benefit in
- 2 excess of \$50 is reported in the statement; and
- 3 (B) the benefit is used solely to defray the
- 4 expenses that accrue in the performance of duties or activities in
- 5 connection with the office which are nonreimbursable by the state
- 6 or political subdivision;
- 7 (4) a political contribution as defined by Title 15,
- 8 Election Code;
- 9 (5) a gift, award, or memento to a member of the
- 10 legislative or executive branch that is required to be reported
- 11 under Chapter 305, Government Code;
- 12 (6) an item with a value of less than \$50, excluding
- 13 cash or a negotiable instrument as described by Section 3.104,
- 14 Business & Commerce Code; [or]
- 15 (7) an item issued by a governmental entity that
- 16 allows the use of property or facilities owned, leased, or operated
- 17 by the governmental entity; or
- 18 (8) transportation, lodging, and meals described by
- 19 <u>Section 36.07(b)</u>.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
