## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to safety standards for elevators, escalators, and related
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 754.015(a) and (b), Health and Safety
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The commission by rule shall provide for:
- 8 (1) an annual inspection and certification of the
- 9 equipment covered by standards adopted under this subchapter;
- 10 (2) enforcement of those standards;
- 11 (3) registration of qualified inspectors and
- 12 contractors;

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- 13 (4) the form of inspection documents, contractor
- 14 reports, and certificates of compliance;
- 15 (5) notification to building owners, architects, and
- 16 other building industry professionals regarding the necessity of
- 17 annually inspecting equipment;
- 18 (6) approval of continuing education programs for
- 19 registered QEI-1 certified inspectors; [and]
- 20 (7) standards of conduct for individuals who are
- 21 registered under this subchapter;
- 22 (8) minimum insurance standards as a condition of
- 23 certification and registration;
- 24 (9) minimum experience and education standards as a

- 1 condition of certification and registration; and
- 2 (10) proposed plans for installation or alteration of
- 3 related equipment to be submitted to the department.
- 4 (b) The commission by rule may not:
- 5 (1) require inspections of equipment to be made more
- 6 often than every 12 months, except as provided by Subsection (c); or
- 7 (2) [require persons to post a bond or furnish
- 8 insurance or to have minimum experience or education as a condition
- 9 of certification or registration;
- 10 [<del>(3) require building owners to submit to the</del>
- 11 department proposed plans for equipment installation or
- 12 alteration; or
- [(4)] prohibit a QEI-1 certified inspector who is
- 14 registered with the department from inspecting equipment.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Commission of Licensing and
- 16 Regulation shall adopt the rules required by Section 754.015,
- 17 Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, not later than
- 18 November 1, 2011.
- 19 (b) A person is not required to comply with the rules
- 20 adopted under Section 754.015, Health and Safety Code, as amended
- 21 by this Act, before January 1, 2012.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
