12	in which the vehicle will first be operated on a public highway; or
13	(B) the department in Austin or at one of the

15	(2) paying a fee, in cash or by postal money order or
16	certified check, of:
17	(A) \$5 for a one-trip permit; or
18	(B) \$25 for each 30-day period; [and]
19	(3) furnishing evidence of financial responsibility
20	for the vehicle in a form listed under Section 502.153(c); and
21	(4) providing proof of the person's identity using a
22	state-issued driver's license or personal identification
23	<u>certificate</u> .
