H.B. No. 2644

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to providing proof of identity to obtain a one-trip or
3 30-day trip permit for the transit of certain unregistered
4 vehicles.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 502.354, Transportation Code, is amended
7 by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (j) to read as
8 follows:

9 (e) A person may obtain a permit under this section by:

10 (1) applying on a form provided by the department to:

11 (A) the county assessor-collector of the county
12 in which the vehicle will first be operated on a public highway; or

13 (B) the department in Austin or at one of the
14 department's vehicle title and registration regional offices;

15 (2) paying a fee, in cash or by postal money order or
16 certified check, of:

17 (A) \$5 for a one-trip permit; or

18 (B) \$25 for each 30-day period; ~~and~~

19 (3) furnishing evidence of financial responsibility
20 for the vehicle in a form listed under Section 502.153(c); and

21 (4) providing proof of the person's identity using a
22 state-issued driver's license or personal identification
23 certificate.

24 (j) The department or a county assessor-collector, as

1 appropriate, shall keep a record of an applicant's proof of
2 identity provided under Subsection (e)(4) in the database the
3 department or county assessor-collector uses to record information
4 about permits issued under this section.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
