SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act in amending Article 63.001(3), Code of Criminal Procedure, applies only to the 1-32 1-33 1-34 1-35 report of a missing child made under Chapter 63, Code of Criminal 1-36 Procedure, as amended by this Act, on or after the effective date of this Act. The report of a missing child made before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the report was made, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-37

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
