A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to operating permit fees for air pollutant emissions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 382.0621, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (d-1) and
- 6 (d-2) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Except as provided by Subsections (d-1) and (d-2) [this
- 8 section], the commission may not impose a fee for any amount of
- 9 emissions of an air contaminant regulated under the federal Clean
- 10 Air Act Amendments of 1990 (Pub.L. No. 101-549) in excess of 4,000
- 11 tons per year from any source.
- 12 (d-1) On and after September 1, 2001, for a facility that is
- 13 not subject to the requirement to obtain a permit under Section
- 14 382.0518(g) that does not have a permit application pending, the
- 15 commission shall:
- 16 (1) impose a fee under this section for all emissions,
- 17 including emissions in excess of 4,000 tons; and
- 18 (2) treble the amount of the fee imposed for emissions
- 19 in excess of 4,000 tons each fiscal year.
- 20 (d-2) The commission by order may annually adjust the limit
- 21 provided by Subsection (d) on the amount of emissions on which the
- 22 fees under this section are imposed so that the fees are sufficient
- 23 to cover the costs described by Subsection (b).
- 24 SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Commission on Environmental

- 1 Quality shall adopt rules required to implement the change in law
- 2 made by this Act not later than December 31, 2012.
- 3 (b) The change in law made by Section 382.0621, Health and
- 4 Safety Code, as amended by this Act, applies to an annual fee
- 5 imposed on or after January 1, 2012. An annual fee imposed before
- 6 January 1, 2012, is governed by the law in effect on the date the fee
- 7 was imposed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 8 purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
