- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 7.052(a) and (c), Water Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The amount of the penalty for a violation of Chapter 37
- 8 of this code, Chapter 366, 371, or 372, Health and Safety Code, or
- 9 Chapter 1903, Occupations Code, may not be less than \$50 or greater
- 10 than \$5,000 [exceed \$2,500] a day for each violation.
- 11 (c) The amount of the penalty for all other violations
- 12 within the jurisdiction of the commission to enforce may not $\underline{\text{be less}}$
- 13 than \$50 or greater than \$25,000 [exceed \$10,000] a day for each
- 14 violation.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 13.4151(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 (a) If a person, affiliated interest, or entity subject to
- 18 the jurisdiction of the commission violates this chapter or a rule
- 19 or order adopted under this chapter, the commission may assess a
- 20 penalty against that person, affiliated interest, or entity as
- 21 provided by this section. The penalty may be in an amount not <u>less</u>
- 22 than \$100 or greater than \$5,000 [to exceed \$500] a day. Each day a
- 23 violation continues may be considered a separate violation.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

- 1 a violation that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 A violation that occurs before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 $\,$ covered by the law in effect at the time the violation occurred, and
- 4 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
