4	SECTION 1. Chapter 161, Health and Safety Code, is amended
5	by adding Subchapter V to read as follows:
6	SUBCHAPTER V. CHILDHOOD HEALTH PROGRAM GRANTS
7	Sec. 161.601. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "department"
8	means the Department of State Health Services.

- 9 <u>Sec. 161.602. CHILDHOOD HEALTH PROGRAM GRANTS. (a) The</u>
 10 <u>department shall develop and implement a grant program to support</u>
 11 <u>programs related to childhood health, fitness, and obesity</u>
 12 <u>prevention.</u>
- 13 (b) The department shall request proposals for the award of
 14 a grant under the program. The department shall evaluate the
 15 proposals and award a grant based on a proposed program's
 16 quantifiable effectiveness and potentially positive impact on the
 17 health of children who participate in the program.
- (c) A grant awarded under this section must be made to an organization that has committed resources to the program described in the proposal.
- 21 (d) A grant recipient may use grant money received under 22 this section only to pay for activities directly related to the 23 purpose of the grant program as described by Subsection (a) and may 24 not use grant money for fees or advertising.

- 1 (e) The department shall establish procedures to administer
- 2 the grant program, including a procedure for the submission of a
- 3 proposal and a procedure to be used by the department to evaluate a
- 4 proposal.
- 5 (f) The department shall enter into a contract that includes
- 6 performance requirements with each grant recipient. The
- 7 department shall monitor and enforce the terms of the
- 8 contract. The contract must authorize the department to recoup
- 9 grant money from a grant recipient for failure of the grant
- 10 recipient to comply with the terms of the contract.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
