- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 53.001, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (k) The judges of the 191st, 193rd, 254th, 255th, 256th,
- 8 298th, 301st, 302nd, 304th, 330th, 14th, 44th, 68th, 95th, 101st,
- 9 116th, 134th, 160th and 162nd District Courts and the county courts
- 10 at law in Dallas County may each appoint one or more bailiffs that
- 11 the judges believe are necessary for the efficient administration
- 12 of the judge's court.
- 13 SECTION 2. To be eligible to be appointed bailiff for the
- 14 191st, 193rd, 254th, 255th, 256th, 298th, 301st, 302nd, 304th,
- 15 330th, 14th, 44th, 68th, 95th, 101st, 116th, 134th, 160th and 162nd
- 16 District Courts and the county courts at law in Dallas County, or
- 17 under Section 53.001, a person must be at least 21 years old and
- 18 hold a peace officer license under Chapter 415 from the Commission
- 19 on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on September 1, 2011.
