- 9 armed services of the United States during an academic year for
- 10 which the student receives a scholarship under this subchapter
- 11 because the student is under a contract with that branch shall be
- 12 deducted from the amount of the scholarship awarded to the student
- 13 for that academic year; and
- 14 (2) after a deduction under Subdivision (1) is made,
- 15 the student is entitled to any remaining amount of the scholarship
- 16 awarded to the student under this subchapter for that academic
- 17 <u>year</u>.
- 18 SECTION 2. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 19 shall adopt rules for the administration of Section 61.9774(b),
- 20 Education Code, as amended by this Act, as soon as practicable after
- 21 this Act takes effect. For that purpose, the coordinating board may
- 22 adopt the rules in the manner provided by law for emergency rules.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
