A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorizing local governments to convey real property
- 3 interests to other local governments for less than fair market
- 4 value.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 272.001, Local Government Code, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (1) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) Except for the types of land and interests covered by
- 10 Subsection (b), (g), (h), (i), $[\frac{or}{2}]$ (j), or (l), and except as
- 11 provided by Section 253.008, before land owned by a political
- 12 subdivision of the state may be sold or exchanged for other land,
- 13 notice to the general public of the offer of the land for sale or
- 14 exchange must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in
- 15 either the county in which the land is located or, if there is no
- 16 such newspaper, in an adjoining county. The notice must include a
- 17 description of the land, including its location, and the procedure
- 18 by which sealed bids to purchase the land or offers to exchange the
- 19 land may be submitted. The notice must be published on two separate
- 20 dates and the sale or exchange may not be made until after the 14th
- 21 day after the date of the second publication.
- 22 (1) The notice and bidding requirements provided by
- 23 Subsection (a) do not apply to a donation or sale made under this
- 24 subsection. A political subdivision may donate or sell for less

- 1 than fair market value a designated parcel of land or an interest in
- 2 real property to another political subdivision if:
- 3 (1) the land or interest will be used by the political
- 4 subdivision to which it is donated or sold in carrying out a purpose
- 5 that benefits the public interest of the donating or selling
- 6 political subdivision;
- 7 (2) the donation or sale of the land or interest is
- 8 made under terms that effect and maintain the public purpose for
- 9 which the donation or sale is made; and
- 10 (3) the title and right to possession of the land or
- 11 interest revert to the donating or selling political subdivision if
- 12 the acquiring political subdivision ceases to use the land or
- 13 interest in carrying out the public purpose.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
