A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the regulation of orthotists and prosthetists.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 605.002(14) and (18), Occupations Code,
- 5 are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (14) "Orthotics" means the science and practice of
- 7 measuring, designing, fabricating, assembling, fitting, adjusting,
- 8 or servicing an orthosis under an order from a licensed physician,
- 9 chiropractor, or podiatrist, or a nurse or physician assistant with
- 10 <u>authority delegated by a licensed physician, chiropractor, or</u>
- 11 <u>podiatrist</u>, for the correction or alleviation of a neuromuscular or
- 12 musculoskeletal dysfunction, disease, injury, or deformity.
- 13 (18) "Prosthetics" means the science and practice of
- 14 measuring, designing, fabricating, assembling, fitting, adjusting,
- 15 or servicing a prosthesis under an order from a licensed physician,
- 16 chiropractor, or podiatrist, or a nurse or physician assistant with
- 17 authority delegated by a licensed physician, chiropractor, or
- 18 <u>podiatrist</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 605.2515, Occupations Code, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- Sec. 605.2515. ADDITIONAL LICENSE: DEVICE MANUFACTURER.
- 22 A person licensed to practice orthotics or prosthetics who
- 23 measures, designs, fabricates, fits, assembles, adjusts, or
- 24 services an orthosis or a prosthesis under an order from a licensed

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- physician, chiropractor, or podiatrist, or a nurse or physician 1 2 assistant with authority delegated by a licensed physician, chiropractor, or podiatrist, for a specific patient is exempt from 3 4 licensing as a device manufacturer under Subchapter L, Chapter 431, 5 Health and Safety Code. A person licensed to practice orthotics or prosthetics who fabricates or assembles an orthosis or a prosthesis 6 without an order from a licensed physician, chiropractor, or 7 podiatrist, or a nurse or physician assistant with authority delegated by a licensed physician, chiropractor, or podiatrist, for 9 a specific patient is required to be licensed as a device 10 manufacturer under Subchapter L, Chapter 431, Health and Safety 11 Code. 12
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
