- 2 relating to a parent's right to object to physical fitness
- 3 assessment of the parent's child by a school district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.101, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) or (c), a school
- 9 district annually shall assess the physical fitness of students
- 10 enrolled in grades 3 through 12.
- 11 (c) A school district may not assess a student if the
- 12 student's parent notifies the district in writing that the parent
- 13 objects to the assessment. A school district shall inform parents
- 14 of the right to object under this subsection and provide parents
- 15 with a reasonable opportunity to notify the district of an
- 16 objection. In this subsection, "parent" includes a person standing
- 17 <u>in parental relati</u>on.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 19 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
