4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 261, Family Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 261.313 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 261.313. ABUSE OR NEGLECT BY FOSTER CHILD. (a) The
8	department shall review investigations of child abuse or neglect in
9	which the department has determined abuse or neglect was committed
10	by a child in foster care against another child in foster care.
11	Based on the information from the review, the department shall
12	analyze the factors that contribute to abuse or neglect described
13	by this subsection and make recommendations regarding:
14	(1) methods of identifying a child in foster care who
15	is at risk of abuse or neglect from another child in foster care;
16	(2) services necessary to prevent abuse or neglect
17	between one or more children in foster care;
18	(3) whether a report of abuse or neglect committed by a
19	child in foster care should be included in the central registry of
20	abuse or neglect; and
21	(4) for cases in which the abuse or neglect results in
22	a criminal charge against a foster child, whether the child's
23	record should be expunged after a certain period has elapsed with no
24	further acts of abuse or neglect committed by the child.

- 2 report the results of the review and analysis and make
- 3 recommendations under this section to the governor, the lieutenant
- 4 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
- 5 standing legislative committees with primary jurisdiction over the
- 6 department.
- 7 (c) This section expires January 1, 2014.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
