A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 2 relating to the state Medicaid program as the payor of last resort.
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 5 is amended by adding Section 32.04242 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 32.04242. PAYOR OF LAST RESORT. The executive
- 7 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 8 adopt rules to ensure, to the extent allowed by federal law, that
- 9 the Medicaid program:

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- 10 <u>(1) is the payor of last resort; and</u>
- 11 (2) provides reimbursement for services, including
- 12 long-term care services, only if, and to the extent, other adequate
- 13 public or private sources of payment are not available.
- 14 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 15 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 16 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 17 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 18 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 19 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
