released on parole or to mandatory supervision; 1 2 (B) is not serving a sentence for, and has not been previously convicted of, an offense listed in or described by 3 Article 62.001(5), Code of Criminal Procedure; and 4 (C) is not a releasee with respect to whom a 5 6 summons may not be issued under Subdivision (1). 7 (c-1) A [The] summons issued under Subsection (c) must state 8 the time, date, place, and purpose of the hearing. 9 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a person who on or after the effective date of this Act is charged 10 with a violation of the terms of the person's release on parole or 11 to mandatory supervision. A person who before the effective date of 12 this Act was charged with a violation of the terms of the person's 13 14 release is governed by the law in effect when the violation was 15 charged, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
