- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1951.206, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1951.206. RULES RESTRICTING ADVERTISING OR
- 8 COMPETITIVE BIDDING. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the
- 9 department may not adopt a rule restricting advertising or
- 10 competitive bidding by a person subject to regulationed by the
- 11 department under this chapter.
- 12 (b) The department may adopt rules restricting advertising
- 13 or competitive bidding to prohibit false, misleading, or deceptive
- 14 practices by a person subject to regulationed by the department
- 15 under this chapter. A rule adopted under this subsection may not:
- 16 (1) restrict the use of any medium for advertising;
- 17 (2) restrict a person's personal appearance or use of a
- 18 person's voice in an advertisement;
- 19 (3) relate to the size or duration of an advertisement
- 20 by a person; or
- 21 (4) restrict a person's advertisement under a trade
- 22 name except that the department may adopt a rule requiring the
- 23 license name of the pest control business on all advertising.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
