4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1951.101, Occupations Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1951.101. COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP. (a) The committee
8	consists of nine members appointed by the commissioner as follows:
9	[(1) two members who are experts in structural pest
10	control application;
11	[(2)] (1) three members who represent the public;
12	[(3) one member from an institution of higher
13	education who is knowledgeable in the science of pests and pest
14	control;
15	[(4)] <u>(2) three</u> [one] member <u>s</u> who represent[s] the
16	interests of structural pest control operators and who $\underline{\operatorname{are}}$ [is]
17	appointed based on recommendations provided by a trade association
18	of operators;
19	[(5)] (3) <u>three</u> [one] member <u>s</u> who represent[s] the
20	interests pest control operators involved in school integrated pest
21	management [of consumers; and
22	[(6) the commissioner of state health services or the
23	commissioner's designee].
24	(b) Members of the committee serve staggered four-year

terms. The terms of four or five members, as appropriate, expire on
February 1 of each odd-numbered year.

3 (c) Service on the committee by a state officer or employee4 is an additional duty of the member's office or employment.

5 (d) Appointments to the committee shall be made without 6 regard to the race, color, disability, sex, religion, age, or 7 national origin of the appointee.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
