A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to grants to student clubs for dropout prevention.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 29.095(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (c) The commissioner may award a grant in an amount not to
- 7 exceed \$5,000 in a school year to a school district on behalf of a
- 8 student club at a district high school campus with a student
- 9 population at least 50 percent of which are students at risk of
- 10 dropping out of school [that is eligible under the criteria
- 11 established under Section 39.408]. To be eligible for a grant, the
- 12 student club and the club's sponsor must be sanctioned by the campus
- 13 and district. A grant awarded under this program must be matched by
- 14 other federal, state, or local funds, including donations, in an
- 15 amount equal to the amount of the grant. A district shall seek
- 16 donations or sponsorships from local businesses or community
- 17 organizations to raise the matching funds. The commissioner may
- 18 award a grant on behalf of more than one student club at a campus in
- 19 the same school year.
- SECTION 2. Section 39.408, Education Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- Sec. 39.408. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CERTAIN GRANT
- 23 PROGRAMS. A school district or campus is eligible to participate in
- 24 programs under Sections 21.4541, [29.095,] 29.096, 29.097, and

- 1 29.098 if the district or campus exhibited during each of the three
- 2 preceding school years characteristics that strongly correlate
- 3 with high dropout rates.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
