- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2161.253(d), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (d) If a state agency determination is made that the
- 8 contractor failed to implement the subcontracting plan in good
- 9 faith, the agency, in addition to any other remedies, may:
- 10 (1) consider the contractor's failure to implement the
- 11 subcontracting plan as substandard performance under the contract
- 12 when evaluating the contractor's bids in the award of future agency
- 13 contracts; or
- 14 (2) bar the contractor from further contracting
- 15 opportunities with the agency.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
